Week at a glance

Goodbye Curtis was our story this week. This is a realistic fiction story about a mailman and his last day of work. His community throws a surprise party for him. Ask your student to retell you the story. High frequency and vocabulary words this week are: addresses, clerk, grown, honor, pour, route, kittens, steps, miss, surprise, and shop. Please continue to study them.

In math we have been working on subtraction of 2 digit numbers. We have now figured out that we can use addition to check

our subtraction. Please encourage your students to work on this at home. Continue practicing fluency of addition facts up to 18. Our goal is to be able to do 20 facts in a minute. Study with your student by using flash cards.

In language arts this week we have been working on action verbs and letter writing.

The weather has been constantly changing and it has been helpful to us as we observe different types weather for our science.
