Emperors Egg was the story for the week. This is a nonfiction informational story about penguins. High frequency and vocabulary words this week are: flippers, hatch, horizon, miserable, slippery, waddled, dinner, important, nothing, seem, and stay. Please continue to study them.

In math we have started our subtraction of 2 digit numbers. We are now working with and without

regrouping with our subtraction. Continue practicing your fluency for our addition facts up to 10 – some have already moved to 18. Our goal is to be able to do 30 facts in a minute. Study with your student by using flash cards.

Our language arts this week has us working with describing words of one- two – and three.

We have had a couple of experiments as we continue with weather in science.
