## Week at a glance

**E**mperor's Egg was the story for the week. This is a nonfiction informational story about penguins. High frequency and vocabulary words this week are: flippers, hatch, horizon, miserable, slippery, waddled, dinner, important, nothing, seem, and stay. Please continue to study them. Our class has had fun studying about penguins as well as watching parts of "March of the Penguins."

In math we are studying different forms of measurement (inches, centimeters, meters, feet, yards, as well as units of capacity). Keep practicing double digit addition and subtraction with regrouping as well as time.

Our language arts this week has us working with describing words that we can use to compare (larger and largest).

We have started our science unit on habitats. Discussing what living things need to survive. Next week we will start discussing forest habitats.
