Week at a glance

This week students practiced number words eleven through twenty. In Math we studied solid figures (cube, sphere, rectangular prism, etc.). We continue to practice different strategies for addition and subtraction which includes doubles, doubles plus one, and making 10. We continue to learn to count by 2, 5, 10 to help us get to the answer.

Next week we will be reading Mr. Putter and Tabby Fly the Plane. Our phonic/spelling for this week will be common abbreviations. For grammar we will be reviewing more plural nouns as well as continuing our Daily Oral Language practice.

In Math our concept will be money. Students will be able to identify the different coins (dime, nickel, penny, quarter, and half-dollar). By the end of the year students should be able to identify bills and coins and be able to count the value of a collection of coins and bills to \$10.00
