Week at a glance

This week our story was "How I Spent My Summer Vacation." High frequency and vocabulary words this week are: imagination, captured, manners, matador, plains, relax, vacation, rock, fire, wait, train, and tell. Please continue to study them.

In our math class we are practicing working on adding 2 digit numbers with and without regrouping. We continue to practice our fluency of addition facts up to 10. Our goal is to be able to do 30 facts in a minute.

Study with your student by using flash cards.

Language arts this week has us working on describing words and continuing with sentence structure.

In science we have been working with weather – exciting - hot, cold, sunny, etc. – lots to discuss. We will continue with this unit for awhile. The students have been asked to pay attention to the high and low temperature as we are graphing it for the month.
