Week at a glance

Chinetown was our story this week. This is a realistic fiction story about a boy who lives in Chinatown and he describes the sites and sounds he encounters. Ask your student to retell you the story. High frequency and vocabulary words this week are: celebrations, develop, furious, graceful, grocery store, students, men, duck, cooks, oil, and lion. Please continue to study them.

In math we continue learning Geometry with shapes and figures – 2D and 3D shapes along with symmetry. As always, we

continue reviewing and practicing both subtraction and addition. This is a skill that needs to be practiced and practiced. Please encourage your students to practice at home.

This week in grammar we have talked about verbs: has, have, and had. Students continue learning many new vocabulary words to go along with and identify parts of the sentence. It is exciting to learn and develop our skills.

We continue with our unit with balance and weighing in science. We have experiments and vocabulary to learn.
